Further information has come to hand regarding ex NSWGR 4809 reported rebuilt in issue #37 as yet the rebuilding of this locomotive with a Caterpillar engine has not been completed. The locomotive rebuilt and released by Gemco Rail Forrestfield is 864 being renumbered from 48s30 that was delivered to Gemco on 25th July 2008. This locomotive it appears retains its rebuilt Alco engine and was hauled by D48 from loco ladder Forrestfield to Gemco Rail/South Spur yard at Bellevue on August 18th to complete its rebuilding.

LZ3109, SCT003 & DC2215 ran 7025 Kalgoorlie freight out of Forrestfield on August 15th with SCT003 being detached at West Kalgoorlie on 16th then hauled dead attached on 1443 freight to Esperance arriving mid morning on August 17th for crew training. It is believed the two SCT locomotives will be utilised in iron ore pool which is currently 13 Q class [one spare unit now located in Esperance], two G and one L/LZ.

MA1862 hauled gauge converted EMU set #85 from old workshops Midland to Claisebrook on August 20th

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Delivery of the AC4300 locomotives model C43aci from builders United Group Rail at Broadmeadow NSW to ARG Forrestfield commenced on August 17th with AC4301 being dead attached to 1BM7 QR National intermodal behind LDP005 & LDP006 at Glenlee yard in Sydney. LDP005 and LDP006 hauled AC4301 to Melbourne where it was detached at North Dynon on August 18th and attached 3MA6 P&O container train. CLP11, CLP13, LDP001 and dead attached AC4301 ran 3MA6 from Melbourne to Adelaide arriving on 19th. On arrival in Adelaide on August 19th AC43001 was detached from 3MA6 and dead attached behind CLP12 & G516 on 4AP1 QR National intermodal for the run to ARG Forrestfield. Unfortunately CLP12 failed on ARTC line and was detached at Nurina about 495kms east of Kalgoorlie on August 20th with G516 hauling the service to Parkeston where LQ3122 was attached to lead of train for the run on WestNet Rail EGR line to Forrestfield. LQ3122, G516 & dead attached AC4301 arrived in Forrestfield about 0500 on August 21st AC4301was then hauled to workshop for commissioning.

LZ3111 ran 6WNI light engine from West Kalgoorlie to Nurina on August 21st to rescue CLP12.

LQ3122 & G516 ran 7PA4 QR National intermodal out on August 22nd that saw LQ3122 run through to Adelaide being the first time an L class locomotive has lead a train from Parkeston to Port Augusta. When L class locomotives ran on AN services in mid 1980's they were always remote units.

QR National 2819 that was converted to standard gauge for use on QRN intermodal operations and never a great success was hauled dead attached on 7AP1 intermodal behind CLP10 & CLP9 out of Adelaide on August 15th arriving in Forrestfield about 0710 on 17th. 2819 will be converted back to narrow gauge at ARG Forrestfield workshop and will see use in mineral haulage on ARG services.
