PTA train control introduced ARS [Automatic Route Setting] of the CTC signalling at 2010 February 18th on Thornlie line, followed at 2015 on Armadale line. Under this system a service at terminating station does not get a proceed indication to commence its run until one minute before the service is timetabled to depart. As the service passes a proceed signal the next signal in advance clears to proceed and so on setting up the signals that may result in drivers being able to red signals in the distance.

D48 hauled AK car track inspection cars to Leonora on February 15th returning to Kalgoorlie around 2245. D48 returned light engine from Kalgoorlie to Bellevue on 16th, with 2210 departing on 17th running AK inspection train interstate over ARTC line.
