In order to undertake a number of tests in relation to the operation and train dynamics of running a long and heavy iron ore train on the undulating line from Geraldton to Perenjori a trial of 108 AHCF wagon empty ore wagons was conducted on April 13th. This trial involved the use of three DFZ units running in multiple with P2507 running but off line on run from Geraldton to Perenjori and return to Ruvidini where train was split for a further trial. The DFZ units DFZ2401, DFZ2404 & DFZ2405 and 90 ore wagons were detached being loaded during night then in early hours of 14th tests for starting train and braking were undertaken on number of grades between Ruvidini and Narngulu. This train then ran to Port of Geraldton to unload.

Track work on the dual gauge down main in vicinity of Kalamunda and Roe Highway Bridges saw wrong line running and train order working in place between Forrestfield and Cockburn on April 8th through 11th.

QR National has commenced new intermodal service 2MP1 that departs Melbourne on Monday arrives at Forrestfield on Thursday departing Forrestfield on Friday and arriving back in Melbourne on Monday. 6007 & CLP1 ran the first 2MP1 in on April 15th and return east as 6PM1 on April 16th.

Gindalbie Metals announced on April 12th it has signed a long term agreement with QR's national bulk freight business to haul its iron ore from Karara mine to Geraldton. This agreement is expected to lead to a 10 year rail haulage contract to Port of Geraldton for export of iron ore initially from Morawa then following building an 85km line east from Tilley siding Karara mine.

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
