Avonlink railcar set failed at PTA depot Kewdale around 1700 on April 29th efforts to get it going were not successful. Spare two-car Prospector set was utilised to run evening service to Northam about 30 minutes late and subsequent morning service to Midland on 30th. Repaired Avonlink on 30th ran to East Perth Terminal 0800 to run thrice weekly Merredin service while substitute Prospector cars ran back to Kewdale.

Eight AC4300 locomotives will be named after shire/town/city councils that the standard gauge network passes through following the results being announced of a staff naming contest.

BHPBIO SD70MACe locomotive 4329 has been named Pilbara, 4328 Wikirrpa, 4336 Redmont.

NR65 & NR62 on 4PM6 hit a cow about 1800 on May 6th around 1430km about 15kms west of Rawlinna causing the usual broken brake pipe that crew quickly repaired. Some of the animal was dragged under the locomotives caused minor damage to crew car and caused small rupture in its fuel tank that was sealed.

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To enable heavy services, locomotive changeovers etc light engine movements are now run by ARG on Wednesdays between Forrestfield and Narngulu. DFZ2407 ran 4755 light engine to Narngulu on May 5th.

The isolation and lack of services on Trans line means the weekly Indian Pacific passenger service picks up on westbound journey and drops off eastbound return mailbags at Forrest, Nurina, Rawlinna and Naretha.

Up to three services per day six days a week ran from West Merredin to Trayning from April 6th until May 3rd on a line that had had services suspended last year. The future of this line is very doubtful with its closure recommended and this may well have been the last services to run.

Overcrowding on trains and lack of parking at stations remains a major complaint of suburban patrons even though more parking spaces are being provided on Mandurah and Clarkson lines. With EMU set #90 having recently arrived but not yet commissioned and the order for new EMUs not yet completed some small relief to overcrowding will be obtained. With the way the suburban system patronage is increasing rapidly consideration will have to be given to obtaining further EMUs and running all services as six car sets on very busy Clarkson Mandurah line.

Complaints about safety and ease of access to Canning Bridge Station that is situated below Canning Highway and in midst of Freeway makes pedestrian access very difficult and parking in Como area adjacent to the station is virtually non existent as there is no parking areas near by. Queens Park station on Armadale line is to receive an upgrade. Oats Street station in a dangerous location adjacent to very busy grade crossing will be subject of a study as to possible relocation with improved parking.
