7GP1 SCT Parkes service behind SCT010 & SCT008 suffered failure of SCT008 at Kingoonya SA around 1700 on August 8th when was to cross 7DA2 freight that detached ALF20 and attached behind SCT units for the run west. Departing around 1900 as SCT010, SCT008 fuel tanker ALF20 reaching Mt Christie SA around 2220 now about five and a quarter hours late. 7GP1 run across the desert was given priority by ARTC control reaching Haig about 0620 on 9th now only fours hours late at this time eastbound service 1PM9 behind SCT002 & SCT015 was departing Parkeston. Locomotive charge over would take place probably at Goddards with 7GP1 locomotives hauling 1PM9 to Adelaide while 1PM9 locomotives would haul 7GP1 through to Forrestfield, ALF20, SCT008 & SCT010 on 1PM9 arrived at Islington SA around 1030 on 10th.

NJ1605 departed Albany for Wagin on August 6th then ran through to Narrogin on 8th to await arrival of 1462 locomotive and empty wagon movement from Merredin that was withdrawal of AB1501, AB1502 & AB1504 being all narrow gauge locomotives and wagons from West Merredin
