Transport Minister Mr Buswell announced on June 30th a six month trial of a free 4:00am train service on Saturday and Sunday mornings from City on each of the five commuter lines Fremantle, Clarkson, Mandurah, Midland and Armadale. This follows a campaign on Facebook that attracted some 35,000 followers and lobbying by Seb Brodie and Scott Bronsens for this service. This service aimed at Northbridge nightspots patrons who experience difficulty with lack of taxis in getting home will become permanent if receives sufficient patronage. Existing 2:15am services will now depart at 2:00am and is expected to cost about \$1 million over the trial period.

Armadale line beyond Cannington was closed from 7:15pm on Saturday July 2nd to first train on Monday 4th to enable works to take place at Kelmscott on bus interchange and ballast tamping.

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5MP9 SCT Melbourne to Forrestfield freight found broken rail at 1423.800km on north rail that also had sleeper broken arround 0830 on June 25th. QRN intermodal 5MP1 was next service due that crossed it very slowly about 2-3kmph with crew member observing following 5MP1 getting through it was deemed unsafe for any eastbound train to cross arround 1110am. This caused 6PM7, 6PM6, 6PM9 to be held till the break was plated for temporary repair about 1430 with gang departing Parkeston run 350km to perform more perminant repair arround same time and arrived about 1800. This delay of some 3-4 hours to eastbound trains saw the crews run out of time with 6PS7 stabling on crossing loop Forrest 6:40pm till 00:55 am on 26th, 6PM7 stabled croosing loop Reid 8:10pm for mandatory rest period, 6SP6 and 6SP7 wre stabled at Cook till crews had their mandatory rest period, with 5MP7 being relieved by taxi at Zanthus 2045. Further services were delayed east of Cook resulting in delays to services arriving in Kewdale.

P2510 & 2512 returned north to Avon Yard arround June 25th with P2506 & P2517 running south to Albany to operate only grain service running at present on a shortened consist. DD2356 & P2509 have been running woodchip service recently with P2504 being stabled as spare locomotive at workshop.

The remaining SD40s at BHP Billiton Iron Ore that were used on works trains were due to be withdrawn by July 1st following the completion of RGP5 track duplication from Bing to Yandi Junction. Some nine SD40s were involved in this project being 3078, 3079, 3080, in ICE blue and yellow livery, 3086, 3089, 3091, 3092, 3093 and 3097 all in BHPBIO bubble livery stored /stabled at Flashbutt yard Bing, 3082, 3083, 3084 and 3085 are stored at Finucane Island in undercoat while 3081 in undercoat with 3087, 3088, 3090, 3094, 3095 and 3096 all in BHPBIO bubble livery are stored at Nelson Point. SD40s were withdrawn from mainline ore haulage end of October 2009 some still saw occassional use as yard shunters into May 2010.

AC4304, Q4003 dead attached Q4006 & L3118 ran 4314tonne, 1450metre 2426 overnight freight to Forrestfield on June 27th while on 28th 3426 freight ran as Q4012, LQ3121, ALZ3208 dead attached Q4011 for 93 wagons, 5020tonne, 1759metres.
