BHP Billiton Iron Ore commenced the Port Hedland Inner Harbour Project [PHIHB] Rail Expansion Works that is a continuation of Rapid Growth Project 5 on July 1st between 28km to 38km on Mt Newman line also between Finucane Island and Goldsworthy Junction with NRW undertaking the earthworks scheduled to be completed by October 2012. This expansion will see Goldsworthy Junction to Finucane Island line duplicated and a second balloon loop constructed at Finucane Island for Car Dumper 5. A five track staging facility together with a camp and offices will be constructed at Mooka that will also see the access road from Bing to Mooka being upgraded to an all weather sealed road. The loco prep facility at Boodardie will also be extended as part of this Yarrie line duplication.

BHPBIO commenced commissioning 10 new side dump cars and 30 new ballast cars at Bing in early July.

When the Mt Newman line was duplicated south of Bing 10 rail bridges were replaced with larger improved structures these will be progressively removed with stream training and modification work also undertaken.
