Transport Minister Mr Buswell recently announced that the three year \$105million upgrading by local shire councils of rural roads had not progressed to a level that would "satisfactorily service" the upcoming 2011-12 grain harvest. The roads that would carry the grain displaced by Tier 3 wheatbelt lines that in June went on to care and maintenance will not be ready for the forthcoming harvest. The government is investigating extending the operational life of York Quairading, West Merredin Trayning and Bruce Rock through to Yilliminning lines with rail infrastructure operator Brookfield Rail that has been asked if it can undertake the works to get the lines ready. This extension of these lines would only be for the 2011/12 grain harvest with accelerating funding for the road upgrading programme expected to enable its completion by April 2012 with the roads then being able to carry the 2012/13 harvest. The government has continually stated it can see no compelling case to upgrade and continue operation of the Tier 3 rail lines and they will all gradually close in line with recommendations of Strategic Grain Network Committee. Farmer and rural organisations continue to lobby for the Tier 3 lines retention and upgrading.

D1562 still retains its original number and is the last ex Westrail QRN locomotive yet to be renumbered.

Two former Overland cars BJ1 and Club Car3 recently purchased from GSR by GWA for conversion into crew cars were hauled to Forrestfield by SCT on MP9 September 1st for delivery to Gemco Forrestfield for conversion and rebuilding.



6006 & 6001 on 6MP1 haul dead 6005 on its delivery run to QRN WA for use on iron ore train service approaching Kalgoorlie on September 3rd.

6005 arrived on 6MP1 on September 4th joining 6010 and 6002 for use on QRNs WA operations.

AC4401 through AC4403 have been classified ACB but will retain the same numbers now being ACB4401 through ACB4406 when they are all delivered.

ACB4401, 4901 & ACB4402 ran D177 light engine builders trial on September 9th in NSW from UGL Chullora workshop to Penrith returning as D178 light engine Penrith to Chullora. This is the first mainline trial of new ACB class six of which were ordered by ARG from UGL Rail that will now be accepted by QRN for use in WA. These locomotives are a refined version of the 2009 built AC class with further enhancements more akin to recent XStrata XCN class.

ACN4149 and ACN4151 passed through Port Augusta on September 6th arriving in Meckering during afternoon of 9th to overnight then arrived in Forrestfield about 9:00am on the 10th.

DC2208 is now workshops shunter as DC2213 is being upgraded and modified for mainline operation when completed DC2208 will be upgraded. 2201, 2203, 42209, 42211 and 3102 are stored out of use.

EBA disputes continue on QRN WA operations with Esperance being on strike September 1st and 2nd as well as other QRN depots throughout the state. Kalgoorlie depot struck on August 29th but was outside Fair Work Australia protected action parameters with FWA ordering Kalgoorlie depot workers to resume work. It appears the parties are poles apart with no early settlement of this dispute in sight and strike action expected to continue. The on again of again DPU workings are again suspended as part of this industrial action.

Loop extension work continues on Esperance line with northern loop extension at Cowan being completed, self restoring points southern end of Daniel loop have been cut in but northern extension is yet to be cut in.

Loco transfer to Esperance saw Q4012 leading LZ3114 on 3443 Kalgoorlie to Esperance freighter on September 6th.
