Another line in the Mid West now sees iron ore trains abet as a short term measure till the Morawa line and Karara line are completed and commissioned in late 2012. Ore trains commenced running from Mingenew to Geraldton port on January 3rd for Midwest Corporation. The first train 4765 was worked by P2517 & P2502 with these ore trains expected to be worked by ACN locomotives following an initial series of services. Ore is trucked from Sino Midwest Karara Mine to Mingenew where it has been stockpiled waiting commencement of this temporary ore train running. Trains are loaded with front end loaders as is the usual practice with all Mid West ore producers.

An industrial accident occurred in tunnel connecting Perth Underground Station to Clarkson line on January 30th resulting in all work on Perth City Link Project being suspended. This sees work on the new pedestrian tunnel at Perth City Station that was to commence on January 3rd also suspended till further notic
