Mt Lawley station on Midland line reopened January 31st even though work on remodelling and improving disabled access to the station has not been completed with completion expected in April.

Transperth A series EMUs used mainly on the Fremantle, Midland and Armadale have been suffering a number of failures on all lines in last few weeks. Temperatures in this period have varied from maximums of 42 degrees to maximums of high 20s this heat wave may have contributed to these failures but a quite a few of the failures were in the early morning or after dark. Many of these EMUs these have been in service for over 20 years and are now over half way through a service life of about 40 years. With EDI Bombardier now having the maintenance contract for both B and A series EMUs they will be able to co-ordinate maintenance and servicing of all these cars.

With all the suburban lines having now been laid with concrete sleepers stage one temporary heat speed restrictions were only applied on day during the recent heat wave.

The \$360 million project to sink the Fremantle line in a 600m tunnel west of Perth Station removing the line that cuts the CBD off from Northbridge officially commenced on January 31st.
