In past few weeks no one has been hit but there have been quite a few close near misses on the old original lines Midland, Fremantle and Armadale lines. Services were cancelled between Bassendean and Midland from 7:30pm on February 10th till first service on 13th to enable replacing the wooden sleepers with concrete at Woodbridge Station. Prospector services commenced from or terminated at Midland Station on 10th, 11th and 12th. The Indian Pacific service operated as normal into and out of East Perth Terminal on 11th and 12th.

AK car inspection train did its usual quarterly inspection of Brookfield lines Kalgoorlie to Forrestfield and branches to Leonora and Esperance. G&W 2210 ran the inspection train to Forrestfield on February 7th then stabling and returning to Kalgoorlie on 8th, to Leonora on 9th returning on 10th to Esperance on 11th returning on 12th. 2210 was stabled at Kalgoorlie loco while QRN locomotives hauled the AK cars on the lines north and south of Kalgoorlie.

VL357 was hauled to Kewdale behind NR52 & NR79 on 1MP5 arriving on February 15th was then hauled Forrestfield on 16th for delivery to Gemco Rail for attention before being used by Watco till the new CBH locomotives being constructed in US arrive.

Q4014 on 4029 sulphur train hauled ACB4406 & ACB4405 offline overnight to West Kalgoorlie arriving on February 16th with the two ACBs being detached. ACB4405 & ACB4406 with dead L3116 ran 5443 empty fuel train overnight to Esperance arriving on 17th. After inspection and set up the two ACBs were deployed into the ore train pool over the weekend.
