First of 22 CBH new locomotives have rolled off the MotivePower Inc production line in Bosie Idaho this narrow gauge locomotive is painted in CBH livery light blue car body with large areas of dark blue and black bogies and frames. This is a heavy 120tonne narrow gauge Co-Co, 2386kw [3200hp] locomotive the first of six under construction that will be hauled to an east coast US port for export to WA with arrival anticipated in mid May. There is also eleven lighter 96tonne narrow gauge Co-Co, 2013kw [2700hp] locomotives together with five 132tonne Co-Co 2386kw [3200hp] standard gauge units in various stages of assembly. All these units have DPU capacity that will again see grains trains with head and rear end power operating on the wheat lines. Apart from trials previously conducted by ARG these CBH locomotives will introduce DPU operation to standard gauge grain trains. These locomotives fitted with Cummings [QSK60 V-16 2013kw or QSK78 V-18 2386kw] engines will be US Tier 2 emissions standard compliant with the improved fuel economy of a late model engine.

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First service operated by Watco in WA occurred when leased CFCLA locomotive VL357 ran light engine from Forrestfield where it had been serviced and modified to run on internal WA services by Gemco Forrestfield workshop. VL357 was also turned on Forrestfield turntable around midday March 1st by QRN following its release by Gemco.

VL357 ran down light engine from Forrestfield on March 1st while a CBHS to pack wagon was railed and commissioned at CBH Kwinana. Watco ran it first train on behalf of CBH on March 2nd when ran 6WG3 Kwinana to West Merredin to conduct riding tests and speed trials of CBHS two pack wagons. These trials saw the wagons run at 110km in track speed and riding test in usual test area between Meckering and Cunderdin where over the years speed trials have been conducted for new locomotives and railcars. 6WG3 ran to West Merredin yard to stable returning as 7WG2 to Kwinana on March 3rd.

Latest QRN 6000 locomotive to be allocated to internal WA operations 6011 arrived behind LDP006 & 6006 on QRN intermodal 5MP1 in early hours of February 26th. 6011 ran 1155 light engine Forrestfield to UGR plant Bassendean around midday on 26th to enable its modification to operate in WA. 6011 has never operated on QRN intermodal services to WA having been used on Hunter Valley coal trains in NSW prior to be withdrawn and hauled to WA.

LZ3106 has had its short end nose painted yellow with a QRN loco while its long end is also painted yellow but has not had QRN logos applied.

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Downer EDI announced to Australian Stock Exchange on March 2nd it had been awarded a contract to supply a number of EMD SD70ACe/LCi to BHP Billiton Iron Ore over the next five years. The first of these new locomotives are at present being built in by EMD in Progress Rail Muncie Indiana plant with them expected to be delivered mid 2012. This \$292million contract with options [if exercised] could see total value exceed \$400million. These locomotives will be built in the USA with minor work to install extras like fire suppressant equipment etc fitted on arrival. This order will see the replacement of Goninan /General Electric CM40-8M and General Electric CW6000 locomotives over next few years.
