An association between grain handler CBH [Cooperative Bulk Handling] and state railway operator which commenced over 80 years ago officially ended on April 30th. This grain haulage at first undertaken by WAGR and refined over the years into a very efficient bulk train operation that continued after freight rail network was sold. CBH put the grain haulage task out to contract that was secured by Watco WA Rail Pty Ltd who took over the grain haulage task on May 1st. QR National ran grain trains out of Geraldton, Albany and Avon Yard on the final day a service running to Mingenew from Geraldton, to Cranbrook from Albany, to Brookton, to York, and to Kalanie with a standard gauge grain train loading at Avon. Following unloading all the narrow gauge grain trains ran to Avon Yard to stable on the 30th with the standard gauge grain train being hauled empty to Avon on the 1st with the Geraldton fleet running empty to Forrestfield then on to Avon also on the 1st. The end of QRN hauling grain for CBH doesn't mean that QRN will no longer haul grain in WA. The CBH monopoly on handling of grain was found to be uncompetitive and CBH was stripped of its monopoly, this is before the courts on appeal. Depending on the outcome of this appeal is the long term future of QRN hauling grain. If CBH losses their appeal QRN will be able to offer its services to other grain traders in the state.

ACN4144 ran to Picton April 27th to enter service on south west block mineral trains.

Two week shutdown at Port of Geraldton commenced on May1st to enable further work to be undertaken to upgrade iron ore unloading facilities. SCT015 arrived on 7GP1 at Forrestfield around April 10th under hire to CBH/Watco hauled to Gemco Forrestfield to be modified to suit operating internally in WA. SCT015 ran light engine to CBH Kwinana on May 1st to commence use on CBH grain haulage. VL357, VL361 & SCT015 ran 5WG3 grain to Forrestfield May 3rd where two VLs were detached then ran light engine to Gemco Bellevue for routine maintenance with SCT015 working 5WG3 grain train.

QRN ran 4416 ore train in a different DPU configuration of 2xlocomotives 106 ore cars 2xlocomotives 53 ore cars as a trial ex Esperance on May 2nd running to Koolyanobbing loading and returning to Esperance as 4417 loaded ore arriving May 3rd.

Former wooden Commonwealth Railways cars AF25 lounge car and ARB13 first class sleeping car purchased minus bogies by original owners of South Spur Rail with intentions of restoring both cars for use on their Spirit of the West Dinner train have been donated by Engemco to Boulder loop line. These cars now in poor condition after long term open storage at Maddington and Bellevue were loaded onto trucks and hauled to Boulder on April 26th. It is believed that Boulder Loop line intend to fully restore these coaches.
