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Two more CBH locomotives arrived this week with CBH006 arriving on 9th and was railed at North Port on July 10th then hauled to Gemco Forrestfield to be commissioned. CBH003 was railed on July 13th following arrival by sea from Savannah Ga then hauled to Gemco Forrestfield to join CBH006 in being commissioned. CBH003 was the locomotive that would always arrive out of sequence as it spent some time at the DOT Pueblo Colorado Railroad test centre late April into May being hauled to and from Bosie Idaho under cover as WAMX2703. CBH003 underwent a test programme fitted with powered standard gauge bogies then returned to the builder for forwarding to Savannah for export.

42209 has been returned to workshop Forrestfield from outside the old tubs where it had been stored for sometime to have more parts removed as it continues to be slowly stripped.

GM30 under the previous ownership of the ARG was to be the prototype of a proposed GM rebuild that had been partially rebuilt before QR bought ARG and suspended the rebuilding. GM30 was stored, then offered for sale as is last year but failed to sell. Some parts had been removed earlier in the year but in the last week it was removed from the old tubs shed where it was stored hauled to the Forrestfield workshop and stripped. The shell of GM30 is now stored outside the old tubs pending decision on its disposal.

More CM40-8 locomotives have arrived from Dampier for overhaul with 9417 and 9420 having been hauled from where they were stored in LIA Karratha to UGR Bassendean during week ending July 13th.

P2505 & P2517 damaged when hit by a truck at Mooliabeenee on May 17th and derailing remain stored near old narrow gauge service shed adjacent to Forrestfield workshop.

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P2503, DBZ2308 hauling dead attached DD2358 ran as 3362 empty grain train out of Albany July 10th to Lake Grace that saw DD2358 being dropped off at Wagin to be hauled to Avon yard. DD2358 ran as 6376 light engine Avon yard to Forrestfield on July 13th.

NR57 failed with front bogie wheel set problems on 3SP7 at Bonnie Vale evening of July 5th was then hauled back to West Kalgoorlie by NR84 at 30kmph and stabled in West Kalgoorlie yard. NR84 then turned on Binduli triangle and ran light engine back to Bonnie Vale to run 3SP7 Express service to Kewdale with NR119 third unit that had remained on 3SP7. NR57 was driven slowly from West Kalgoorlie to Kalgoorlie loco for repair on July 6th.

ALZ3208 has been spare unit at Kalgoorlie recently but ran 5442 fuel train to Leonora on July 12th owing to Q4017 failing at 168km on 4029 sulphur that saw Q4016 on 4478 nickel having to rescue Q4017 and cause some disruption on Leonora line. 5443 empty tankers were also worked back to Kalgoorlie by ALZ3208.
