Brookfield Rail has commenced the largest CTC installation in WA since Westrail replaced the electric staff safe working system with CTC south of Coolup on South West Main line in early 1980s. Commissioning of the new Centralised Traffic Control [CTC] signalling system that's part of Midwest Rail Upgrade Project on Geraldton to Mullewa line commenced at Port of Geraldton on July 15th. This initial upgrade from the Port of Geraldton to Grants at 24 km that includes Narngulu Yard was completed on July 21st. This now sees the existing Train Order System and Self Restoring Points replaced with a three aspect CTC signalling system and powered points controlled by Mid West Train Control at Midland Control Centre. Installing and commissioning of CTC signalling system will continue east to Mullewa over the ensuing weeks until it's fully operational.

A contract has been issued to WA construction company Cooper & Oxley to build the Butler Station at the end 7.5km extension of Northern Suburbs line with construction anticipated to commence before the end of the month. The Butler park and ride terminus station will have a 930 bay car park and 11 new busses to serve routes to this and Currambine stations is scheduled for completion in 2014.

DFZ2401 after having DPU capacity fitted by UGR Bassendean then following system testing ran light engine to Narngulu on July 14th. DFZ2407 also had DPU capacity fitted then undertook system testing at Forrestfield using ACN locomotives as did DFZ2401. DFZ2407 ran light engine trial to Kwinana July 21st then was hauled dead to Narngulu on 7755 light engine movement.

CBH006 ran 6K05 light engine Gemco Forrestfield to CBH Kwinana terminal following commissioning on July 20th. CBH005 is reported to have teething problems and CBH004 is working single consist grain train to Port of Geraldton at present.

ACN4168 and ACN4169 following commissioning were hauled dead attached July 21st on 7755 light engine movement behind DAZ1904 & DFZ2407 to Narngulu to entered service.

EPC brake system is being fitted to several Dash 9 44 CW locomotives in the ECP fit out workshops within the new Rio 8 Mile Yard at Karratha at present in preparation to introduce EPC braking onto Rio rail system in the coming months. Further wagons and locomotives will have this braking system fitted in an ongoing programme over the next few months.

I would like to publicly acknowledge and thank all those people who sent congratulations and kind remarks on the achievement of reaching 200 issues of this e-.Mag.
