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CBH013 following commissioning hauls off line ZB2120 on 3KO8 light engines out of Forrestfield to CBH Kwinana October 2nd to enter service.

Severe disruption to commuter services on Northern Suburbs line occurred around 7:40am on October 3rd when a Perth bound two car A series EMU sets #16 and #47 suffered an incident after leaving Warwick Station. It appears the overhead contact wire was caught up with pantograph tearing the catenary down and lashing along the side of EMU set #16 causing some minor damage. The catenary was bought down for some 1500 metres south from vicinity of Erindale Road to where the four car EMU set came to a stop. There were no injuries in the incident but passengers were kept on the cars until it was safe to evacuate them and busses were at the scene to pick up the passengers. Initially EMU's ran Clarkson to Whitfords with Rail Replacement buses running Whitfords to Leederville and EMU's running Leederville to Perth Underground then onto Southern Suburbs line. About 4:00pm the EMU's were extended to Stirling and Rail Replacement

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busses then ran from Stirling to Whitfords Stations. Repairs were undertaken but it soon became evident that the damage was far worse than first thought with hopes of having repairs affected by early morning of 5th not being able to be achieved. MA1862 ran light engine to Stirling Station out of Claisebrook about 9:30pm on 3rd to recover EMU sets #16 and 47 then crossed over to the up line and attached the EMU's then hauled them back to Claisebrook for repair. Repair crews worked round the clock repairing both the overhead and other transmission infrastructure that also suffered damage in the incident. The catenary was repaired to an extent to be able to run two test trains over the section at very slow speed on afternoon of 5th. Following these tests the line was not immediately reopened but crews continued to work on repairing the overhead. Full services resumed at 11:15pm with first northbound service departing Perth Underground while first southbound service ran out of Whitfords 11:20pm. Following the last five late night runs operating successfully normal services resumed with first services on Saturday 6th.

DBZ2311 overhaul completed ran 6172 light engine to Kwinana on September 28th to undertake a loaded works trial following overhaul out of Kwinana. Following this trial DBZ2311 ran light engine back to Forrestfield as 6122 on October 5th.

K205 ran rail train to Toodyay West on September 29th to distribute rail in Toodyay Avon section. While on October 3rd 8030 and K205 ran 4K05 rail train dropping rail on Woodbridge triangle in the Avon Valley before running east to Hampton.

ZB2120 hauled WAMX3303 [CBH015] to Gemco Forrestfield for commissioning October 2nd that then saw CBH013 enter service by hauling ZB2120 off line from Gemco to CBH Kwinana.
