November saw the recommencement of ore trains between Kooyanobbing and Esperance for new mine owner Mineral Resources. Startup was two rakes of 106 hoppers each led by triple MRLs; following the derailment they became rakes of 84, one with double MRLs, one with MRL + NR. Eventually more NRs were sent to Esperance, and the rakes were increased to 110 hoppers with triple heading, any combination of MRLs and NRs. In early December, a third rake was introduced, with more NRs; several MRLs have been back and forth between West Kal and Perth for servicing or modifications. Occasionally a loco is out of action for a trip or two, with one or two trains reverting to two locos and 84 hoppers for the duration. The first shipload of 105,517 tonnes of Mineral Resources iron ore departed Esperance at 1am on 20<sup>th</sup> December, aboard the MV Birte Oldendorff.

Plenty more has happened in recent weeks – extra services running for the pre-Christmas peak; two of CFCLA's CF class off-hired from the Pilbara have been hauled back east, with the other two to follow, rumours circulate that all six ACBs will do the same. Two VL class with a rake of 66 NGXH hoppers have arrived from NSW for GrainCorp; Q4003 has emerged from overhaul and repaint... but that's December's news, photos in next month's edition.

Finally, with Christmas only days away, I'd like to take this opportunity to wish you and your family a very merry Christmas and a safe and prosperous New Year. May the trains be plentiful and photogenic!
