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It's 0450 and the sun about to rise over Kalgoorlie for the first time in 2019 as 1GP1 crosses Bulong Road into Parkeston behind SCTs 013 & 001, 1st January.

Mt Gibson iron ore trains into Geraldton ceased on 1<sup>st</sup> February following the completion of mining at Extension Hill. Several new projects are possible for the region in the coming months/years, including other iron ore mines and mineral sands, but for the moment the Perenjori branch has become grain only and many P class will be placed in storage, allegedly including 2502, 2504 and 2515. P2503 has already been a parts donor for several weeks, having apparently suffered a major failure.

ACBs 4401 & 4405 were hauled east on 5PM9 ex Perth on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> January; they will join Aurizon's Hunter coal fleet. The other four ACBs are yet to be transferred, with ACB4402 still the only one in traffic. ACC6031, AC4302, AC4303 and AC4305 all remain in storage, along with Qs 4004, 4005, 4010, 4012, 4013 and 4018.

PN's 8222 returned east in early February after several months as the Esperance Port shunter. NR10 is currently performing the shunt duties; the three triple-headed ore trains are running with a combination of MRLs and NRs. Generally one MRL is out for servicing at UGL Bassendean at any time; in late January three were failures, necessitating six NRs on the ore trains to assist the three active MRLs for a week or so. Along with the two fuel train NRs and the port shunter, Esperance had nine NRs!

As this issue was being prepared, 5PS6 derailed just east of Kultanaby in the Tarcoola – Port Augusta section around noon WA time on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> February. 700 metres of the train has piled up, with around 150 metres of track damaged. A deviation was constructed around the site, reopening at 1000 SA time on Thursday 21/2.

A heavy Kalgoorlie focus this month with two railfans visiting the city during January.






