West Australian Rails

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6PM9 (SCT011 / SCT013) struck a stolen Hilux traytop dumped on the tracks between Burracoppin and Carrabin on the morning of Sat 31/8, damaging the lead unit. As "insurance", CSR012 was added to 6MP9 in South Australia and sent west to assist 6PM9 if required. Fortunately SCT011's damage was only cosmetic, so the CSR wasn't needed and continued through to Parkeston, where it was removed and collected by 1PM9 the following morning for return east. 6MP9 pulls up at the eastern yard limit board at Parkeston shortly before sunset to begin the shunt, 1st September; SCTs 008 & 005 leading CSR012.

Q4004 ex long-term storage, ACN4168 and P2515 are all currently being overhauled at Gemco Forrestfield. Q4014 and Q4015 appear to be stored.

Aurizon units on hire to Mineral Resources finally entered service on Koolyanobbing ore trains on 2nd October, when ACC6031 ran light engine from West Kalgoorlie to Higginsville to assist failed loaded ore 4035. Since then, ACC6031 and ACC6032 have become a regular part of the lashups – usually two sets of NR, MRL and ACC, with the third rake being NR + 2 MRLs, and the fourth rake hauled by triple NRs. ACB4402 is currently at Esperance, presumably for crew training.








