CF4405 entered Kooly ore traffic on 12<sup>th</sup> December, with 5030 empty ore departing Esperance that evening as MRL002, CF4405, MRL003. CF4406 ran its first few trips as first or third unit in its lashups, before spending several days "in the shafts", middle of the block of three locos. In recent days it has again moved to alternating first/third on each trip, 5035 loaded ore having CF4406, NR114, MRL005.

Mineral Resources' short-lived experiment with the CHEY hoppers has ended, with half of the hoppers being returned east ex West Kalgoorlie on 3PM4 empty steel service on 10<sup>th</sup> December. The other half are stabled at Parkeston, for collection by 7PX4 on 14/12 else 3PM4 on 17/12.
